Over the last few years, we have been leading our church through an intentional season of refocusing on our mission and values with a desire to see our church experience spiritual renewal and health. We believe this is Jesus' preferred future for Ashburn.

Last year our vision included **Moving Forward** in 3 areas: 1) Creating unity, both missionally and relationally, 2) Developing leaders, both to serve and to send, and 3) Serving our community, both our neighbor and our neighborhood. Among the amazing things God enabled us to accomplish this past year, was fulfilling our vision of developing leaders through the launch of our church planting residencies, in partnership with Send Network and Send Network Espanol. We now have two residency programs (English and Spanish) with three residents who are currently preparing to plant churches in Chicago within the next 2 years. This is amazing, and nothing short of the hand of God. As you are also aware, God opened the door for us to replant the Lighthouse Fellowship as Ashburn Church–Frankfort this past Easter, by His grace.

None of these things were in my heart or mind when I first came to Ashburn five years ago, but all of these opportunities from God have firmly convinced me, beyond all doubt, that God is strategically using Ashburn to catalyze a church planting movement across Chicago, for His glory. God continues to miraculously open door after door, equipping us to follow Him by faith **FOR THE KINGDOM**.

1951

Ashburn Baptist Church holds it's first service in January and organizes in October 1951.





1989

Ashburn expands with a second campus in Orland Park. It expands again with an addition in 1993.

1997

Ashburn launches Ashburn Church – Espanol at our Chicago location.





2019

Ashburn Church – Arabic launches at our Orland Park campus under the leadership of Dr. Wael and Jaqueline Dawahir.



2020

Ashburn Church – Chicago is replanted under the leadership of Josh and Cara Burks.

2023

Ashburn Church merges with Lighthouse Fellowship and replants Ashburn Church – Frankfort on Easter Sunday. Ashburn also launched church planting residency programs in English & Espanol in partnership with Send Network.



2024

Tim & Rose Eborda will plant another Ashburn multisite once they complete residency in early 2024.





OUR MISSIONS PROGRAM

Our focus is to bring clarity to our mission efforts, rather than it simply being a sub-item in our budget that is never mentioned or emphasized. Our mission program is unique and diverse in its outreach. It reflects Jesus' command to take the gospel from Jerusalem to the uttermost parts of the earth. (Acts 1:8)

- 1. **Missionaries** We directly support missionaries in Ukraine, France, and the Philippines.
- 2. **Cooperative Giving** We support the International Mission Board and North American Mission Board through the <u>cooperative program of the Southern Baptist Convention</u>.
- 3. **Residency** A portion of our mission budget is designated to help support our residents in our church planting residency.
- 4. **Church Planters** A portion of our mission budget is also designated to support our current church planters.

OUR CHALLENGE TO YOU

We challenge every congregation to take ownership of generosity in 3 ways:

- 1. **Embrace biblical generosity.** Every believer is commanded to give the tithe joyfully and with gratitude to the mission work of God's kingdom through the local church.
- 2. **Engage missional giving.** We encourage you to give a designated offering **weekly or monthly** to Missions to strengthen our ability to lean into our vision to be a multiplying church across Chicago and the world. A little can make a HUGE difference together.
- 3. Get Equipped through stewardship training. Many would love to engage generosity, but are limited by debt and other factors. We will offer Financial Peace University to help teach biblical principles of good stewardship. You can sign up for classes online at www.ashburn.church.
